

IHYA' RAMADAN: MEDIPA & IMMB. In conjunction with the Holy Ramadhan, the Medical Postgraduate Students Association (MediPA) and IMMB have jointly organized a program to prepare bubur lambuk. This program was successfully conducted on 13th April 2023, from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m led by the MediPA President, **Mr. Amir Muhaimin Akmal Shukri**, and **Amy Suzana Abu Bakar** as secretary. There were three large pots of bubur lambuk cooked during the program by around 30 volunteers from postgraduate students, IMMB, LACU, and Anatomy Department staff. More than 800 packages of bubur lambuk were successfully prepared and distributed to UiTM Sg Buloh staff, students, and visitors. A 360° CAREER VIRTUAL TOUR ABOUT FORENSIC ENTOMOLOGY. A virtual tour by The Waymaker, a career connector platform company was held on 5th April 2023 at IMMB. The Waymaker Legacy is a social enterprise that offers a career consultation program with a 360° virtual career tour and a human-touch career connect group. AP. Dr. Heo Chong Chin, the Director of IMMB and a forensic entomology expert, was chosen to be interviewed based on his extensive expertise and vast fieldwork experience in the field. The information from this tour will be used to develop digital content for potential students and interested individuals to get a glimpse into the world of forensic entomology and to increase the career opportunities available in this field.

IMMB director, Assoc. Prof Dr. Heo Chong Chin was invited as the panel in an AEC Research Webinar titled "Nurturing Innovative Ideas Through Cutting-Edge Research". This webinar was organized by the Analytical and Environmental Chemistry course, Faculty Science and Marine Environment, Universiti Malaysia Terengganu, and was held on 17th April 2023. He shared his expertise on the topic entitled "Forensic Entomology: Concepts and Applications." The other speaker was Dr. Siti Sofo Ismail who is currently working at the School of Marine Science & Environment, University Malaysia Terengganu (UMT), and she talked about "Diatomological Mapping and Partially Submerged Buried Body". Both of the panels are recipients of Yayasan Penyelidikan Antartika Sultan Mizan – YPASM funding grants in 2018.
