

The IMMB INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR SERIES 01/2024, held on 22nd January 2024, featured **Prof. Dr. Hyo-Bang Moon** from the **Department of Marine Sciences and Convergence Engineering** at **Hanyang University**, Ansan, Korea, as the invited speaker. Specializing in biomonitoring studies, Prof. Dr. Moon discussed the application of urine samples as trackers of LMW phthalates research with a presentation titled "Within-and between-person variability of urinary phthalates and bisphenols over seven days: Considerations of biomonitoring study design." The webinar, moderated by Mr. Azhar Ahmad, was attended by 20 physical participants and 103 online participants, which included students and lecturers from UiTM.

IMMB RESEARCH TALK 2024 on 24th January 2024 also featured Prof. Dr. Hyo-Bang Moon. He discussed "Feasibility of Biomonitoring Species for Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) in The Environment." The lecture, chaired by Mr. Amir Muhaimin Akmal Shukri, who is our PhD student and the president of the Medical Postgraduate Students Association (MediPA), attracted 30 participants. Prof. Moon's research primarily focuses on how Persistent Organic Pollutants remain in ecosystems and how we can monitor their levels, ultimately contributing to the development of effective strategies for environmental protection.





IMMB RESEARCH TALK 2024 on 18th January 2024, featured Assoc. Prof. Dr. Siti Sarah Othman from the Faculty of Biotechnology and Biomolecular Sciences, University Putra Malaysia (UPM). She discussed on how to promote STEM education as a business with the title "From Research to Business: Promoting Inclusivity in STEM." The lecture, chaired by Mr. Azhar Ahmad, attracted 25 participants. Assoc. Prof. Dr. Sarah shared her experiences in starting a company, creating a product, and marketing it around Malaysia.

On 22nd January 2024, the IMMB INTERNSHIP SHARING SESSION was held before the interns completed their internships at IMMB. All of them shared their research experiences and findings on the projects they had done during their time there. Nurul Atiqah binti Burhanddin shared her project titled "Insect Succession and Decomposition Stages on Fresh and Frozen-Thawed Fish Carcasses," where she examined the effect of freezing on the rate of carrion decomposition. Nurul Shafiza binti Mohd Nidzam shared her project entitled "Black Soldier Fly and Rat Carcass Decomposition" explaining how she observed Black Soldier Fly being used as a decomposition agent. Fazreen Hazirah binti Zulkiflee shared her experience with the title "My 15 Weeks Experience." She discussed her experience working on projects in IMMB and how she had to abandon her project due to weather constraints and how she could change her methodology in the future.

This initiative aims to facilitate discussions and explore potential collaborations in research and learning between the two institutions.

During this meeting, Mr. Azhar also presented the key features of this system, including inventory management, booking management, and maintenance record storage. These features are crucial for

tracking the equipment in the laboratory. The development of the Laboratory Management System reflects UiTM's commitment to enhancing the efficiency and effectiveness of laboratory operations to better resource management and productivity in laboratory activities.
