VISIT FROM DEANERIES. IMMB is proud to receive a visit from the Dean of Faculty of Medicine, Assoc. Prof. Dr Fazah Akhtar Hanapiah on 7 February 2022. This visit was also attended by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Thuhairah Hasrah Abdul Rahman, Deputy Dean of Research and Innovation, Faculty of Medicine. The Dean had visited several laboratories and research facilities available at IMMB. During the visit, a lot of matters were discussed for improvements including the acquisition of new equipment, internationalization as well as new research niche of IMMB.



After going through various phases of discussion and consideration, **TROPICAL MEDICINE** has been selected as **IMMB'S RESEARCH NICHE**. The selection was based on several factors including the field's potential, capabilities, and research background of existing researchers in the Faculty of Medicine. Therefore, the IMMB Niche Members has been elected to plan, contribute and lead to research advances in this area. Thus far, 14 lecturers have participated and three main focus areas have been selected namely: Dengue, Soil Transmitted Helminths, and Antimicrobial Resistance. Note that these areas will be highlighted without sacrificing or neglecting other ongoing research fields in IMMB. Application to join IMMB Research Niche is open to all academic staff of the Faculty of Medicine throughout the year.



The recording session was conducted on 18 Feb 2022 in collaboration with MERCK Malaysia. The objective of this project is to provide insight to the younger generation and share an aspiration to them as a researcher.

IMMB BASIC LECTURE 2022 was conducted on 9 February 2022. The invited speaker was Assoc. Prof. Dr. Muhd Firdaus Che Musa from Kulliyyah of Dentistry, IIUM Kuantan. In this lecture, he shared with the audience his expertise on the topic entitled "Health Service Research: Ethical and Policy." Health Services Research (HSR)'s main goals are to identify the most effective way to organize, manage, finance, and deliver high quality care; reduce medical errors; and improve patients' safety. In addition, he also touched on the types of health care practices, which are clinical practice and public health practice. This talk was chaired by Mr. Mohd Ameer Azeezy Abdul Wahab and was attended by 125 participants.






IMMB JOURNAL CLUB 2022 was held on 16 February 2022. The invited presenter was Nur Amirah Md Amin (MSc Student) under the supervision of Dr. Akmal Hisyam Arshad. The title of her research findings is "Elucidating The Effect of in Vitro Treatment of Palm Oil Tocotrienol-Rich Fraction (TRF) on **Endometriosis-related Pro-inflammatory and Oxidative Stress** Markers." In this presentation, she shared the potential mechanism of TRF in endometriosis. From her findings, it was concluded that TRF and ETRF treatments significantly increased the cell viability of NECs in a dose-dependent manner, while both treatments significantly decreased the cell viability of PECs at higher concentrations. This talk was chaired by Mr. Hazrul Nizam Hisham Hasmi and was attended by 103 participants.

IMMB RESEARCH TALK 2022 was conducted on 23 February 2022, with Dr. Mohamad Ghazali Masuri from the Faculty of Health Sciences, UiTM Puncak Alam as speaker. In this session, he shared his expertise on the topic entitled "Human Factor and Rehabilitation: Science of Scientific Attitude and Behavior Measurement." This talk touched on human factors and rehabilities, attitude and behavior, measurement, and research examples. From his experience, it was concluded that there are huge potential and opportunities on the attitude and behavior research among Malaysians. This talk was chaired by Mr. Azhar Ahmad and was attended by 60 participants.


