IMMB INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR SERIES 05/2022 was conducted on 30 August 2022. The invited speaker was Dr. Abby Jones, a Post-Doctoral Researcher under the supervision of AP. Dr. Heo Chong Chin. She shared with the audience her research interests and current research entitled "Effects of Mass Death on Community Structure and Ecosystem Function." The objectives of her research are to identify the rate of decomposition, types of nutrients (soil nutrients or plant tissue) and soil communities (soil microbes and soil arthropods). This talk was successfully attended by 42 participants and chaired by AP. Dr. Heo Chong Chin.



HANDS-ON WORKSHOP: LABORATORY DETECTION OF INTESTINAL PARASITES 2022, organized by the Department of Medical Microbiology and Parasitology (MMP) & IMMB, was successfully conducted on 4-5 August 2022. This workshop consisted of a lecture and a series of laboratory work led by IMMB Niche Scholar, Dr. Azdayanti Muslim and assisted by facilitators and committees from MMP, IMMB and MPG of the Faculty of Medicine UiTM. Dr. Azdayanti herself delivered a talk entitled "Laboratory Methods for the Diagnosis of Intestinal Parasites" to 26 participants. Based on the organizer's observations and feedback from the participants, this workshop successfully achieved its objectives through the sharing, laboratory works and evaluation that had been prepared.

IMMB RESEARCH TALK 2022 was conducted on 3 August 2022. The invited speaker was Dr. Kuhan Chandru A/L Balasanthiran from Institut Perubahan Iklim, University Kebangsaan Malaysia. In this session, he shared his expertise on the topic entitled "A Quick and Dirty Primer on Unrevealing The Origin of Life." From his findings and studies, it was concluded that the direct history of prebiotic chemistry to modern biology and its biomolecules may be the clues to deciphering the origin-of-life. This talk was chaired by AP. Dr. Heo Chong Chin and was attended by 29 participants.





IMMB BASIC LECTURE 2022: SEMINAR ASAS PENGENDALIAN BAHAN KIMIA was conducted on 17 August 2022, with ChM. Hajatun Rabani Ahmad Razif, Registered Chemist from Engineering College, UiTM Shah Alam as the invited speaker. She shared her expertise in the proper way to handle chemicals, starting with the purchase, receiving, storing and disposing of the chemicals. This sharing session was chaired by Mr. Mohd Yusri Idorus and was successfully attended by 52 participants. The attendance was recorded as one of the laboratory audit preparations and requirements that will be checked during the laboratory audit by the authorities.

As one of the leading researchers in this field, he is passionate about sharing his knowledge and understanding through research and industry platforms. This talk was chaired by AP. Dr. Heo Chong Chin and was attended by 36 participants.





An IMMB JOURNAL CLUB was conducted on 24 August 2022. The invited speaker was ChM. Naizah Zakaria from the Anatomy Department, Faculty of Medicine UiTM. In her talk, she shared her experience about "Rat Dissection for Histological Slide Preparation." This sharing session was very helpful for students who are currently involved in *in vivo* studies. Each dissection procedures was explained in detail and was understandable through the various pictures and notes. This lecture was successfully attended by around 37 participants and was chaired by Mr. Hazrul Nizam Hisham Hasmi.

Dr. Mohd Danial Bin Mohd Efendy Goon obtained his Bachelor of Biomedical Science from International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) in 2012. From 2012 until 2013, he was trained at the D10 (JSJ) Division under the Royal Malaysian Police (RMP). He attended Perdana University Graduate School of Medicine (PUGSOM) from 2014 until 2018 before pursuing Master of Science (Medicine) at Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), Sg Buloh campus. In 2019, he converted his Master to Doctor of Philosophy (Medicine). During his PhD, he won Best Poster Presentation at the 3rd ICMBB and 3rd place in the 3MT competition at UiTM's faculty level.

He was also awarded with European Association for the Study of the Liver Young Investigator Bursary Award, published several original articles including Nature's Scientific Reports and ended his PhD with the award Anugerah Penyelidik Cemerlang (APC) and candidate for the Anugerah Kedoktoran Cemerlang Tuanku Canselor (AKCTC).

Currently, he is holding the position of post-doctoral researcher under IMMB Internal Advisor, AP. Dr Siti Hamimah Sheikh Abdul Kadir. During his post-doctoral research, Dr. Danial works with two UITM's post-graduate students and multi-discipline experts in developing methods for detections of endocrine-disrupting chemicals (EDCs) and correlates them with patients' biochemistry profile. He hopes that his team's investigation would able to shine light on the devastative effect of EDCs on human health and policies and regulations will be enforced by regulatory bodies under the government of Malaysia.
